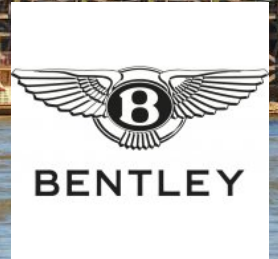




## Silver Shadow, Bentley “T” and Derivatives

### A Weekend in Echuca



**Friday 4<sup>th</sup> April to Monday 7<sup>th</sup> April 2025**

We invite you to come to the heart of the Murray, the town of Echuca for a fun weekend.

This year is the anniversary of the inception of the Silver Shadow and Bentley T models, their Diamond Anniversary.

The weekend will be hosted at the Mercure Port of Echuca, ph (03) 5482 5666. If you do not already have your accommodation booked, phone and quote “Rolls-Royce”. Members are responsible for their own room bookings and payment.

Echuca is an Australian town in northern Victoria. It is across the Murray River from the town of Moama, in New South Wales. Paddle steamers depart near the Port of Echuca Discovery Centre, which has exhibits on the 19th-century river trade, plus part of the original Echuca Wharf. The Echuca Historical Society Museum is dedicated to local history.

Colbinabbin and Rochester are famous for the painted silos and water tanks, as well as the Rochester mural competition. Winning competition entries are on display in the town.

### Friday 4<sup>th</sup> April

Take a walk around Rochester, visit Iddles Lane and head over to the Police Station to view the display of the winning murals in the annual Mural Competition. Head back to Echuca for lunch at the Americana at 1pm. Lunch will be a selection of dishes.
